SITUATION:

Griggs Green is a small settlement just over a mile west of Liphook. Woodland View is rurally situated within a small cluster of properties, offering a country feel and yet close to amenities. The Old Thorns Golf and Country Club and the renowned 'Deers Hut' public house are within a short walk, with extensive countryside access on the doorstep via Weavers Down. More extensive facilities are available in nearby Liphook with good shopping/café/restaurant/cinema facilities (including Sainsbury's Super Store) and mainline railway station on the Waterloo/Portsmouth line (Waterloo about 1 hour). The A3 London to Portsmouth trunk road is within 0.5 miles giving easy access to Heathrow and Gatwick via the Hindhead tunnel. Haslemere is about 5 miles, Farnham 14 miles, Guildford 17 miles and the South Coast 20 miles by road. Liphook Golf Club and Forest Mere Health Farm are all within about 2 miles. There is good provision of local state schools to include the Ofsted rated 'Outstanding' Liphook junior school, together with Churchers Junior and Highfield & Bookham public schools.

The elegant sitting room features a characterful wood-burning stove and offers a cosy yet refined space to relax or simply unwind while enjoying peaceful views of the front garden.

Three well-appointed double bedrooms each enjoy their own stylish en-suite bathrooms, offering a level of comfort and privacy rarely found in homes of this kind. Thoughtful design and high-quality finishes create a calming feel throughout.

There is also a delightful shaker-style utility/boot room, fitted with a sink, space for both washing machine and tumble dryer, and a separate cloakroom/WC—ideal for everyday convenience and muddy boots after countryside walks.



A standout feature is the fully insulated sweet Shepherd's Hut, tucked within its own private cottage garden, bordered by a picket fence. Perfect as a tranquil retreat, writer's nook or hideaway, it offers an irresistible touch of rural romance, just steps from the main house, yet delightfully secluded.

Located in the sought-after hamlet of Griggs Green, Woodland View offers a rare blend of countryside serenity and convenient living.
