AMBERLEY 95 SANDFORD AVENUE SY6 7AB

Amberley is a detached traditionally constructed period property dating from the early 1900s. It has been well maintained over the years and retains many period features.

In brief it includes: entrance porch, reception hall, ground floor cloak room and WC, kitchen/breakfast room, dining room, sitting room, and second reception room on the ground floor, with a large galleried landing, four bedrooms, a family bathroom and adjoining dressing room/shower room. There is also a separate WC.

The property benefits from gas fired central heating and leaded windows with secondary glazing.

Outside is a garage, generous front garden and forecourt parking. To the rear there is a paved terrace with steps descending to large level gardens with ornamental pond, established flower beds, shrubs, trees, and fruit trees. There is also paved access to the side of the house, between the front and rear gardens.

There are vegetable beds, a greenhouse, summerhouse, sheds, and far reaching views to the Stretton Hills.



The Property lies half way up Sandford Avenue on the eastern side of the Stretton Valley.

From its elevated location it benefits from superb panoramic views towards the Long Mynd hills.

The town centre amenities are within about fifteen minutes walking distance.



THE TOWN OF CHURCH STRETTON

Church Stretton lies amidst the south Shropshire Hills between the county town of Shrewsbury (13 miles) and Ludlow (14 miles). It can claim to be one of the most beautifully situated towns in England and attracts walkers and country lovers from all over the UK.

This thriving community benefits from all types of societies, cafes, public houses and restaurants.

Being a popular market and tourist town, it offers excellent shopping facilities, including a supermarket, specialist shops, ladies' and men's fashion shops, and a building society agency based in Wrights Estate Agents.

Including the picturesque neighbouring villages of All Stretton and Little Stretton, it has a population of around 5,000.

There are churches, excellent schools, recreational facilities including an 18-hole golf course, tennis, bowls and croquet.

The 'Mayfair' community centre and GP practice provide a range of health care.

There are good rail and bus services. Telford lies within easy commuting distance. The M54 gives access to the West Midlands and Birmingham.

ENTRANCE PORCH fully glazed with double entrance doors and quarry stone floor tiles.

INNER HALL with carpet, radiator and doors to the cloak room / WC and reception hall.

GROUND FLOOR CLOAK ROOM / WC vinyl flooring, coat hanging area, hand wash basin, two windows, and WC.

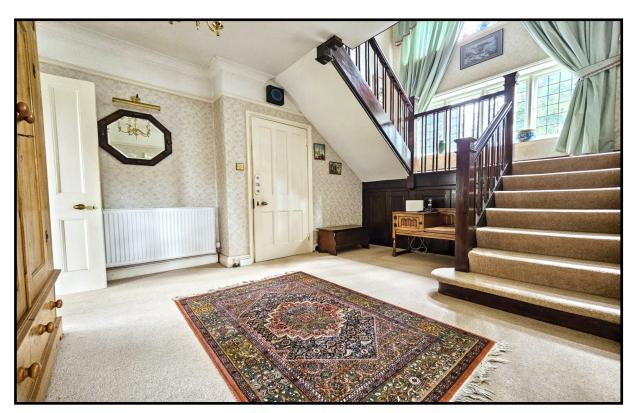
RECEPTION HALL with fitted carpet, radiator, and large sweeping original hardwood staircase to the mid-way landing with large windows, and the first floor.

SITTING ROOM with fitted carpet, two radiators, marble and cast iron fireplace with marble hearth, and large bay window overlooking the front garden.

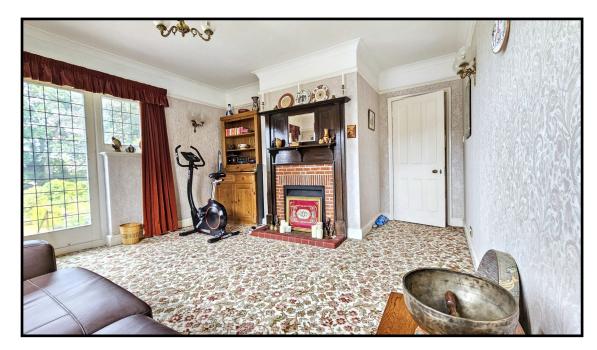
SECOND RECEPTION ROOM/LOUNGE with fitted carpet, original oak frame and brick feature fireplace with gas fire, dual aspect windows, and glazed door to rear that leads out to the loggia, patio, and gardens.

KITCHEN with tiled floor, range of floor and wall units, laminate work surface over, integral gas hob with extractor hood over, sink and drainer with mixer tap, high level integral oven, Worcester central heating boiler, and door leading to rear patio and gardens.

<u>**DINING ROOM**</u> With wood laminate flooring, fitted cupboards, radiator, and windows overlooking the rear gardens.













ACCOMMODATION continued...

<u>First FLOOR LANDING</u> with fitted carpets and enjoying a good dale of light. This useful space could be utilised for some additional

storage, a desk for working at, or a reading area.

BEDROOM 1 with fitted carpet, fitted wardrobes, dual aspect windows, radiator, and door adjoining to bedroom two.

BEDROOM 2 with fitted carpet, radiator, fitted wardrobes, window overlooking the front garden, and door adjoining to bedroom one.

BEDROOM 3 with fitted carpet, radiator, built in storage cupboard and window overlooking rear gardens.

BEDROOM 4 with fitted carpet, radiator, and window overlooking rear gardens.

BATHROOM with wood laminate flooring, part tiled walls, free standing cast iron 'ball and claw feet' bath, wash hand basin, radiator and window.

<u>ADJOINING DRESSING ROOM AND SHOWER CUBICLE</u> with fitted carpet, radiator, window, shower cubicle, and inbuilt airing cupboard

WC with wood laminate flooring, window, and WC.

GARAGE with front up and over door, rear access door to workshop area, power and lighting.

OUTSIDE The property lies well back from Sandford Avenue with generous forecourt parking, a driveway and attractive front gardens with lawns, shrubs, trees and boundary hedgerows.

There are gated paths either side of the house leading to beautifully landscaped mature rear gardens. A paved terrace runs along the full width of the rear of the property with steps descending down to an ornamental pond with patio area and large level gardens with lawns, established flower beds, shrubs, trees and fruit trees. There are vegetable beds, a greenhouse, a summerhouse, several useful sheds, boundary hedges and far reaching views to the Stretton hills.

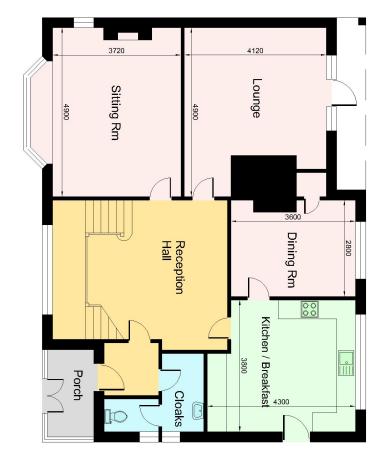

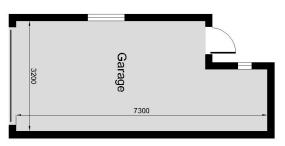

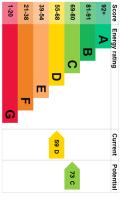


First Floor
