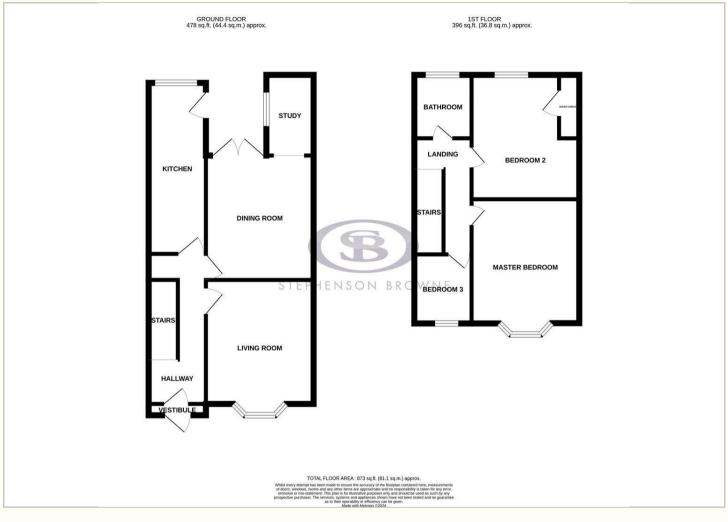

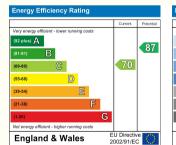


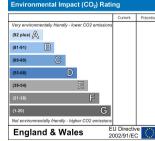
Floor Plans Location Map
