Description

The site offers a rare and valuable opportunity to create a development of new homes in Sutton Cheney, which is an attractive and unspoilt village in West Leicestershire, close to the popular small town of Market Bosworth. Sutton Cheney is a desirable village and developers can be confident that they will be able to create a premium residential product at the site.

Location

Sutton Cheney is approximately 2 miles southeast of the attractive small town of Market Bosworth. The larger town of Hinckley is approximately 4½ miles to the south and Leicester approximately 11 miles to the east. As well as the small community pub planned for the site itself, the village has another very well renowned pub and restaurant, The Hercules Revived, and an active local community including a village hall and church.

Road communications are excellent, with the A447 approximately 1 mile to east which gives access to the M69 and M1 junction about 7 miles to the south. For travelling west, the A5 at Fenny Drayton is about 5½ miles and this in turn gives access to the M42. Birmingham city centre is approximately 33 miles. There is an excellent mainline railway station at Nuneaton with services to Euston in just under an hour and a more local station at Hinckley on the Leicester to Birmingham line. The surrounding countryside is attractive rolling farmland and there is an excellent local footpath network which allows easy access to villages and to Market Bosworth.

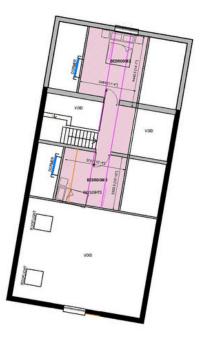
The Site

The site currently comprises a public house and hotel, of which the main part is a period unlisted building of brick and tile construction, together with extensions to the rear. To the rear of this is an 'L' shaped brick and tile range of buildings currently set out as en-suite letting rooms, and nearby is a detached building currently used as a function room. There is also a grass paddock of about 0.7 acres and an extensive car park.

Planning

A planning application (reference 21/01038/FUL) was granted by Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council in July 2023 for the conversion of the buildings to nine residential units.

There is a S.106 agreement requiring the developer to provide a community building as shown on the plans. The building is to be a prefabricated structure with a floor area of about 84m^2 . The S.106 agreement also requires the developer to provide an area of open space, Including an equipped children's play area and to make these available to the Parish Council for future management.

The planning permission includes the retention of two rooms of the main building as a community pub. The developer will need to ensure that the pub rooms are fit for purpose but is not expected to have any involvement in its ongoing management.
