Accommodation briefly comprises a spacious hallway with wood effect flooring and storage cupboard with washer/dryer, a beautifully presented cloakroom with wc, basin and large mirror, a fantastically spacious and contemporary kitchen/breakfast room with a selection of high and low level cupboards, wood effect flooring, integrated oven, hob, extractor fan, fridge/freezer and dishwasher and complete with space for a small breakfast table and stools, an extremely well-proportioned living/dining room complete with carpet to floors, patio doors leading to rear garden and a spacious under stairs storage cupboard.

Upstairs continues with a sizeable bedroom one complete with carpet to floors, fitted wardrobes across one wall with sliding doors and a beautifully presented en suite shower room complete with double length shower, wc, basin, heated towel rail and concealed mirror-fronted vanity cabinet. Bedroom 2 is also an extremely well-appointed double bedroom and again comes complete with en suite bath/shower room complete with bath and shower overhead, wc, basin, concealing mirror-fronted vanity cabinet and heated towel rail.

Outside, the property has the benefit of a low maintenance rear garden laid mainly to lawn with a patio/seating area and a timber framed storage shed. There is allocated parking for 2 vehicles.

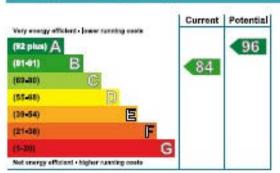
