

Lerry House , Talybont Aberystwyth Ceredigion SY24 5ED Guide price £295,000



A terrace traditional 3/4 bedroomed house of immense character with rear garden overlooking the river Leri.

The property is situated on the southern edge of the village and is approached over an un-adopted road leading to the former historic watermills which are now redundant.

The accommodation is well laid out on the lower, ground and first floor. Lerry house retains most of the original features and is well worthy of inspection. The rear garden (on two levels) has a glorious setting overlooking the river. There is a parking area included in the sale which is located to the fore.

The village of Talybont is 7 miles or so to the north of Aberystwyth on the A487 coastal trunk road. The village has a good range of local amenities to include a village stores, garage and primary school. The aforementioned town has a good range of amenities to include secondary schools and national retailers. The market town of Machynlleth is some 11 miles to the north and the coastal resorts of Borth and Ynyslas are also nearby.
