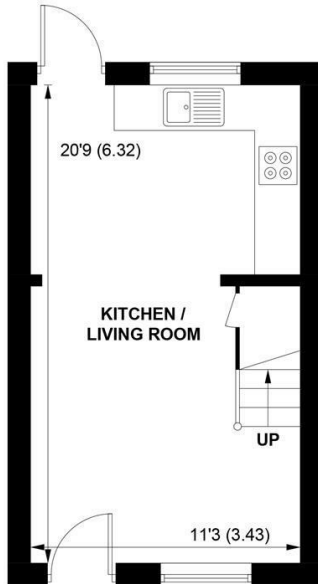


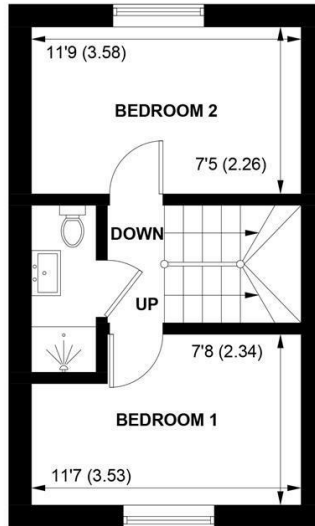

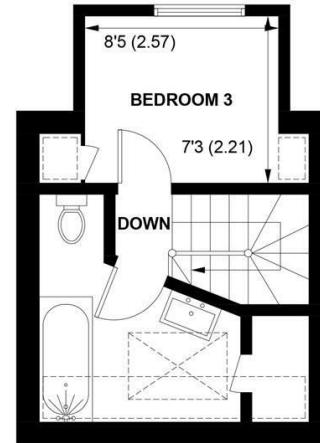


GROUND FLOOR

The ground floor comprises an open plan living/kitchen is dual aspect, has wooden flooring throughout and a useful under the stairs cupboard.
