

A charming terraced cottage located in the heart of Arundel's historic old town, just a short walk from local shops, restaurants, and cafés. Arundel mainline railway station, with direct services to London, is also within easy reach.

On the ground floor, the property opens into a welcoming sitting room featuring a characterful open fireplace. A separate dining room enjoys its own feature fireplace, a built-in storage cupboard, and pleasant views of the courtyard garden.

The kitchen is fitted with a range of base units, providing ample space for appliances and additional storage. Adjoining the kitchen is a well-appointed family bathroom and access to the rear courtyard.
