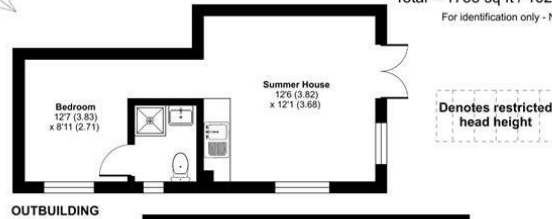




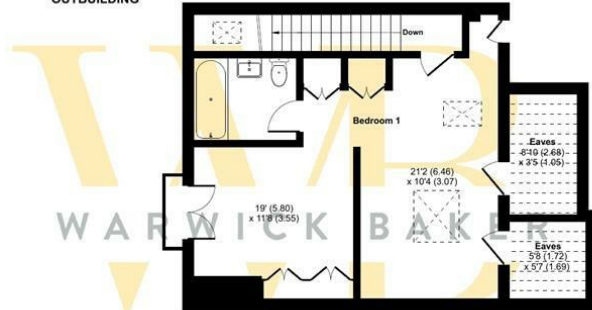

OUTBUILDING

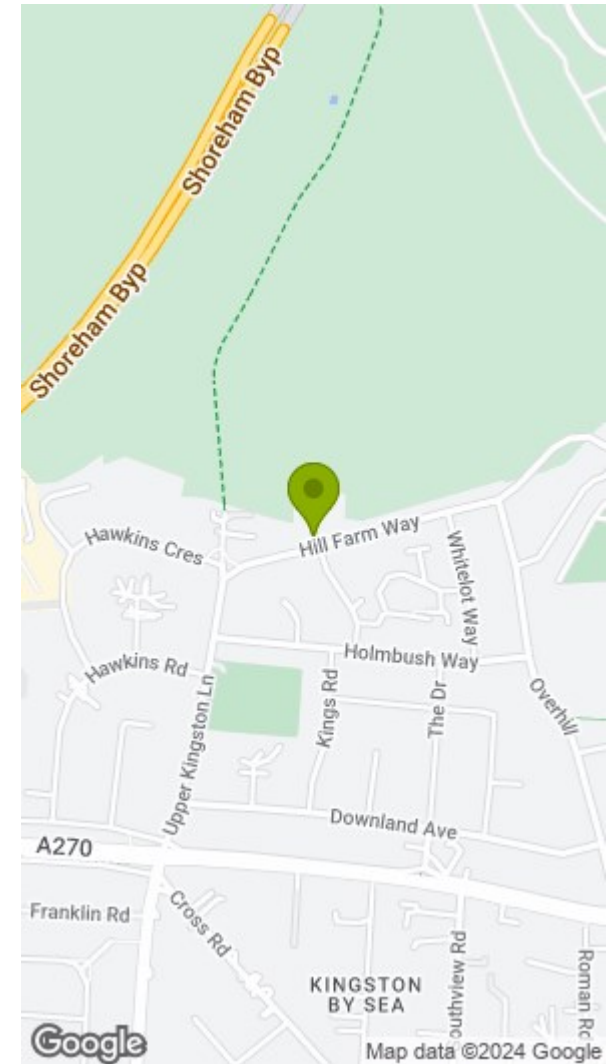


FIRST FLOOR
