But it is the ground floor extension to the rear that truly redefines the way you live. Walk through and you enter a breathtaking open-plan kitchen, dining and family room, a space that lifts the spirit and invites connection. With soaring Velux windows above and two sets of elegant French doors opening to the garden, the entire space is bathed in natural light from dawn until dusk.

The kitchen itself is a masterclass in contemporary design, with a beautiful blend of pale and dark grey cabinetry providing ample storage.









High-end integrated appliances are seamlessly tucked away, including two ovens, a wine chiller, and a dishwasher, while a sleek island takes centre stage, crowned with a mixed-fuel induction hob and stylish extractor above. An enclosed large kitchen larder is neatly integrated within the tall double cupboard, offering even more storage for all your culinary essentials. This is a kitchen made for entertaining, for cooking feasts with family, and for sipping a morning coffee in the stillness before the day begins.

The open-plan space flows naturally into a generous dining area, the setting for Sunday lunches and celebration dinners. 

The main bedroom offers a calming retreat, complete with crisp decor and built-in wardrobes, ideal for keeping everything in its place. The second bedroom, another spacious double, retains its period charm with an original cast iron fireplace that adds warmth and nostalgia. Two further bedrooms, equally well presented, provide perfect spaces for children, guests, or an additional home office. Each room feels fresh, serene and ready to move into.

The family bathroom brings a touch of modern luxury, with a contemporary suite including a panel bath with shower over, vanity wash hand basin, low level WC, and stylish black fixtures that add a bold, boutique touch.

Step outside and the garden becomes an extension of your living space. A wide paved patio stretches across the back of the house, perfect for outdoor dining or relaxed weekend breakfasts. Beyond, a neat lawn and tiered railway sleeper beds filled with seasonal planting and splashes of colour, while a raised decked seating area offers the perfect shady nook to curl up with a book under the leaves of a mature tree. 





