

On Foot: From the Market Place take the A417, Wallingford Street, and Beckett House will be found on your right hand side after about 250 yards

By Car: Leave the Market Place at the south east corner, taking the A338 Newbury Street. At the traffic lights turn left onto Ormond Road. After passing the fire station on your left take the first turning left into Maryfield. As the road swings to the right proceed straight ahead into the parking area for Beckett House.
