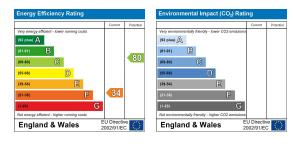

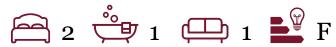

Property Description

Welcome to this double fronted, traditional character cottage which has been completely renovated by the present owners and offers comfortable, tasteful and spacious accommodation.

The property is located in the rural village of Capel Garmon in the Snowdonia National Park and just a short drive to the renowned inland resort of Betws Y Coed.

On entering the property the front entrance is covered by a solid oak and slate open porch with the front door leading into the dining kitchen. This a spacious room with feature fireplace and stunning oak and glass open tread staircase leading to the first floor. There is a convenient door to the rear of the property which opens to the small rear yard area. A range of newly fitted wall and base units along with built in oven and ceramic hob, overhead extractor fan, integrated dishwasher, washing machine and fridge freezer.

The living room is again with underfloor heating is spacious with feature fireplace housing a log burning stove and overlooking the front garden and views of the Snowdonia Mountain Range.

The bathroom comprises four piece suite with shower cubicle, panelled bath, WC, wash hand basin and underfloor heating.

To the first floor you will find two double bedrooms and an additional WC with vanity wash hand basin.

To the outside there is a tarmacadam driveway with ample off road parking, a raised lawned area and patio seating area along with a good size timber shed.
