The Location. . .

'Oakdene' is a Victorian house conversion situated on the sought after Paddockhall Road. The property falls within walking distance of the extensive shopping facilities provided by the town centre, while the mainline station is a half-mile distant and provides fast & regular commuter services to London (approximately 47 minutes of London Bridge/Victoria), Brighton and Gatwick International Airport. 'Miller & Carter' steak house is also just a short stroll. The Broadway is the 'social hub' of the town centre and offers a selection of bars, restaurants and cafes including Zizzi, Pizza Express. Independent bars include the popular 'Orange Square'. ' By car surrounding areas are easily accessed via the A272 and A23(M), with the latter lying approximately six miles west at Warninglid/Bolney.
