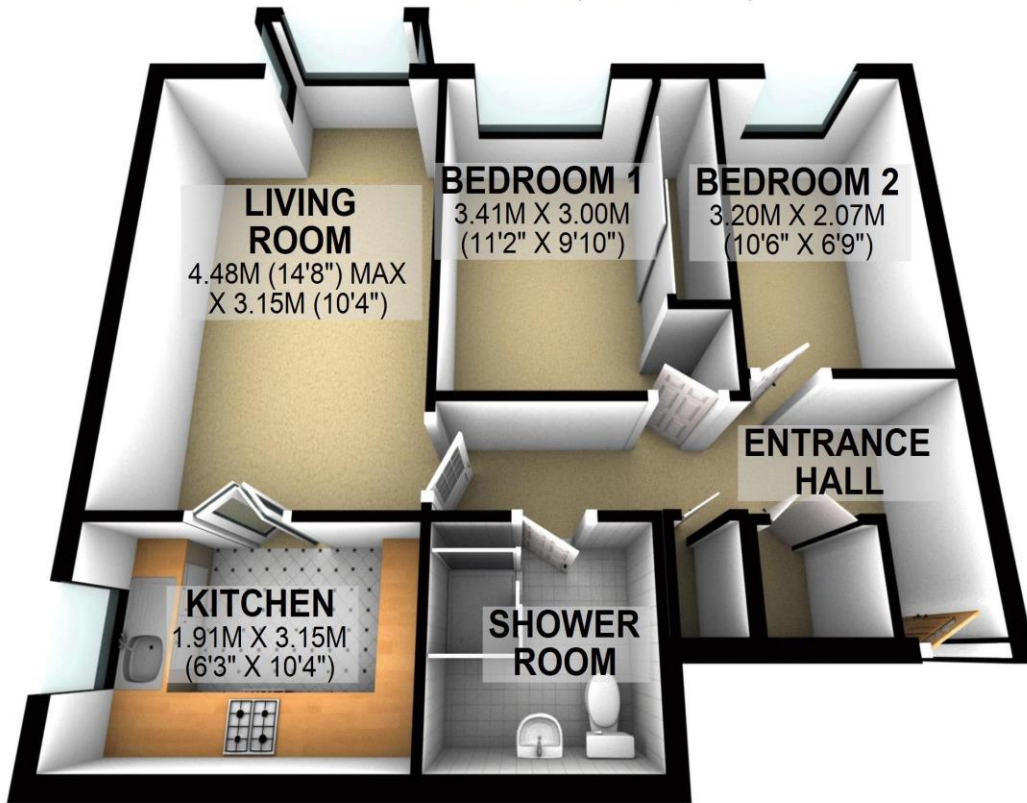

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## About this property

A newly modernised ground floor two bedroom apartment situated in the sought-after retirement development of Priory Gardens. The property is offered in super condition, having been newly decorated and carpeted throughout. The kitchen has been re-fitted and includes built in appliances including a fridge, freezer, oven, microwave oven and an induction hob. The shower room has also been renewed with a walk in cubicle and electric shower. Externally a west facing patio has been created with lovely views towards St Mary's Priory. The property is conveniently located just behind St Marys Church, a level walk of some 250 metres from the main town centre with its wealth of shops and amenities. Further benefits include new electric radiators, double glazing, new internal fire doors, excellent storage throughout, access to the beautifully maintained communal grounds and parking. Priory Gardens is served by an on-site Estate Manager four days a week and has guest accommodation available for a nightly charge consisting of a twin room with en-suite facilities.

## About the location

A popular market town nestled amidst the Seven Beacons with its skyline dominated by the Blorenge and the Sugar Loaf mountains, Abergavenny is known as the 'Gateway to Wales'. It is situated twelve miles from the English border and just south of the Black Mountains in the Brecon Beacons National Park. Steeped in history Abergavenny was originally a Roman Fort then a medieval walled town. It is now a market town with arguably more life than nearby Usk and Monmouth. It offers a wide range of amenities with major supermarkets, weekly retail and farmers markets, a high street comprising of recognized chains and local department stores, leisure centre, a number of churches and Nevill Hall Hospital. Its location means that Abergavenny acts as the major transport hub for the area. The railway station allows easy access to anywhere on the rail network. The A465, Heads of the Valleys Road is one mile out of town with the M50 / M4 a further 25 minutes away. Furthermore there is a large bus station with an extensive range of routes to neighbouring towns and villages and as far afield as Cardiff.

## Directions

From our office in Cross Street (NP7 5EU) follow Monk Street (A40) north and take the first right into Lower Monk Street. Continue for some 300 yards and Priory Gardens can be found on the right hand side.
