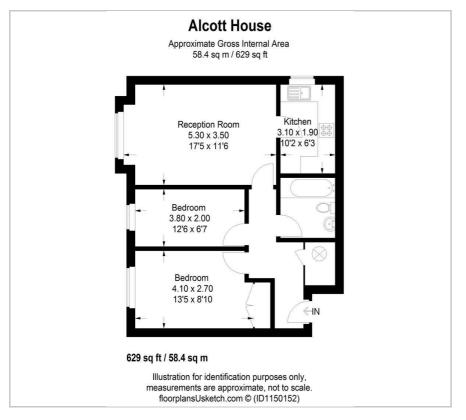








Floor Plan Area Map
