Floor Plan



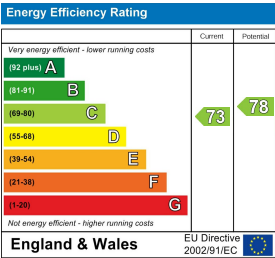
