






Location

The land is situated abutting the south Cornish coast at Perran Sands, also known as Mount's Bay Beach, at the southern periphery of the village of Perranuthnoe, a stone's throw from The Cabin Beach Café together with the nearby public car park and is a short walk from the popular Victoria Inn. The main A394 road, which links Penzance to the west and the former market town of Helston to the east, is about ¹/₂ of a mile away and Rosudgeon is about 1¹/₂ miles away.
