

3.36 Acres of Land, Releath Common Farm, Black Rock, Camborne, TR14 9NR



Three gently sloping field enclosures extending to approximately 3.36 acres with road access. Used in recent years for hay cutting but equally suited to hobby farming, livestock grazing or equestrian use.

Location

The land is situated on the outer fringes of Black Rock, a small hamlet equidistant from the towns of Camborne and Helston. The nearest every day amenities are available in nearby Troon, Four Lanes and Praze an Beeble whilst Camborne and Helston offer a wide range of facilities as well as a mainline railway link to London (Paddington) from Camborne.

The Land

The land comprises three gently sloping field enclosures bounded by Cornish stone and live growth hedging, all enjoying a wonderful open aspect across largely unspoilt countryside. It has been used in recent years for hay cutting but is equally suited to hobby farming or livestock grazing. The land extends to 3.36 acres or thereabouts in all.

From the highway to the west is a verge over which the vendors have benefitted from a vehicular right of way for many years allowing access into the fields independent of the farmstead and there are interconnecting gates between the enclosures.

There are two gateways to the eastern boundaries of the land being sold which enter land being retained by the vendors and the purchaser will be obliged to fill these gateways within six months of completion.

Directions

Leaving Four Lanes in a southerly direction towards Burras, turn right at the bottom of the hill signposted Beacon and Troon. Follow this road (B3280) for approximately two miles and as the road bears sharply to the right, turn left signposted Farms Common and Releath. Continue along this road for a little over half a mile and the gateway to the land will be found on the left hand side identified by a Lodge & Thomas for sale board.

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
