GENERAL AND SITUATION

Approximate Distances:

Crymych 1.5 miles ● Cardigan 10 miles ● Narberth 11 miles St Clears 15 miles

A private equine yard set in approx. 13 acres with four stables, shelters, tack room and hard-standing, with easy access to the Preseli Hills and within the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park

There are two field gate entrances onto council maintained Mynachlogddu Road. The main entrance leads onto a hard surfaced yard upon which there are **Two Timber Stable Buildings** providing **Four Loose Boxes** each 12' x 12' (c.3.6m x 3.6m), a **Tack Room** and a **Shelter** 12' x 12' (c.3.6m x 3.6m). The stables have skylights providing natural light, and there is some solar lighting on the yard. There is a further **Double Shelter** 24' x 12' (c.7.3m x 3.6m) made and installed by Hunters Stables.

In January 2023, planning permission was granted under application no. NP/22/0432/FUL for a new welfare unit/store with ecological enhancements (mainly in retrospect) Further details are available from the Agents.

The Land adjoins the stables in four main enclosures of gently sloping pasture with a south-easterly aspect.

There are spectacular views from the top two fields and access to superb riding along the country lane for a short distance, which leads to a number of bridleways and onto the Preseli Hills. Also close by are the many well-known sandy beaches along the Pembrokeshire coast at Newport Sands and Poppit Sands.
