

A transformation of a grand Victorian villa...

Beverley Court is an exciting new residential development of a well-known York building, located on Shipton Road. Just one mile from the centre of York and overlooking Homestead Park, Beverley Court offers a stunning location for modern living.

The original Beverley House was built in the late 19th century and served as the family home for the general manager of the Rowntree's factory. Over the years, it also housed the offices for the Joseph Rowntree Trust and the Local Government Ombudsman.

The Beverley Court development pays homage to its rich local history and the pioneering Rowntree family, by retaining the historic name of Beverley House and naming the three new buildings Appleton House, Seebohm Lodge and Homestead View.

The development is an exemplary project, blending the fully modernised grand Victorian villa with the fabulous, bespoke new build homes.

The City of York offers a perfect blend of historical charm and modern amenities, making it an attractive destination to live. Known for its iconic landmarks like York Minster, the Shambles and the City Walls, it exudes a medieval history at every turn.

York has a vibrant cultural scene including museums, theatres, music venues and annual festivals and many award-winning restaurants. It has several well-regarded schools with St Peter's & Bootham schools just a short walk from Beverley Court.

The city boasts excellent transport links, with direct trains to London, Manchester, Newcastle and Edinburgh and is located just 30 miles from Leeds Bradford Airport and has easy access to the M1 & M62 motorways and beyond.







Yorkshire Dales



The Yorkshire Dales is a national park located northwest of York and renowned for its breathtaking landscapes of rolling hills, deep valleys and picturesque limestone formations. Home to many charming towns and villages, historic castles and abbeys.

Outdoor activities abound, with numerous cycling, caving and hiking opportunities, including the famous Yorkshire Three Peaks challenge.

Yorkshire Coast

The Yorkshire coast is renowned for its rugged cliffs, sandy beaches and charming seaside towns. From the dramatic landscapes of Flamborough Head to the historic fishing port of Whitby, the coast offers diverse attractions.

The beautiful beaches of Scarborough, Filey and Bridlington are just over a onehour drive from York and provide a classic seaside experience, as well as surfing and paddle boarding for the water sport enthusiasts.

North Yorkshire Moors

The North Yorkshire Moors is a breathtaking national park and boasts vast expanses of heathercovered moorlands, dramatic valleys and forests.

This diverse landscape is interspersed with picturesque villages and historic sites, including the ruins of Rievaulx Abbey and the charming market town of Helmsley and villages of Goathland and Hutton-le-Hole.

The North Yorkshire Moors Railway offers a nostalgic steam train journey through this stunning scenery.



Yorkshire Wolds

The Yorkshire Wolds, located to the east of York, are a range of gently rolling hills and valleys, offering stunning countryside views. The Wolds are dotted with charming villages, historic churches and ancient monuments.

The area is perfect for cycling and walking, with trails like the Yorkshire Wolds Way providing a scenic route through this beautiful landscape. There are plenty culinary delights to enjoy in this part of Yorkshire, with several wineries and local food producers.

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Energy efficient: Beverley Court has a B-rated Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) and photovoltaic solar panels have been installed on the roofs of the new buildings to provide electricity for the communal areas.

Paying tribute to Seebohm Rowntree, Joseph Rowntree's son and an eminent social reformer, who ran the family cocoa and chocolate business until his retirement in 1941. Seebohm Lodge is a unique single-story, detached property with two bedrooms.

APPLETON HOUSE

Appleton House is named after Thomas Appleton, the general manager of the Rowntree's factory, who lived at Beverley House with his family in the early 20th century.

The new building has five apartments across three floors including an impressive 3-bed penthouse apartment with a substantial terrace.

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Homestead View overlooks Homestead Park, opened in 1904 by Seebohm Rowntree. It is the third new building and consists of six 1- & 2-bed apartments across two floors.

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High spec apartments

With generous ceiling heights and large windows, the apartments across Beverley Court are spacious, modern and filled with lots of natural light. Bathrooms and kitchens are finished to a high standard of luxury specification and quality flooring finishes run throughout.

- Sheraton shaker style cabinets in Beverley House with antique brass handles and slab style cabinets (no handles) in the new builds. Both styles in a limestone colour.
- Quartz worktops and upstands in Vienna Gold.
- Neff induction hobs with Neff ovens and separate microwaves or combi ovens and Bosch fridge freezers and dishwashers.
- Gunmetal 4-in-1 hot water taps and gunmetal undermounted 1.5 bowl sinks.
- Separate utility with storage, including space for a washing machine, dryer and wiring position for WIFI router.
