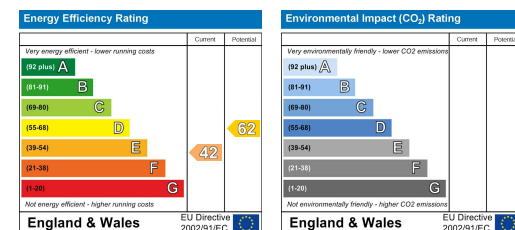

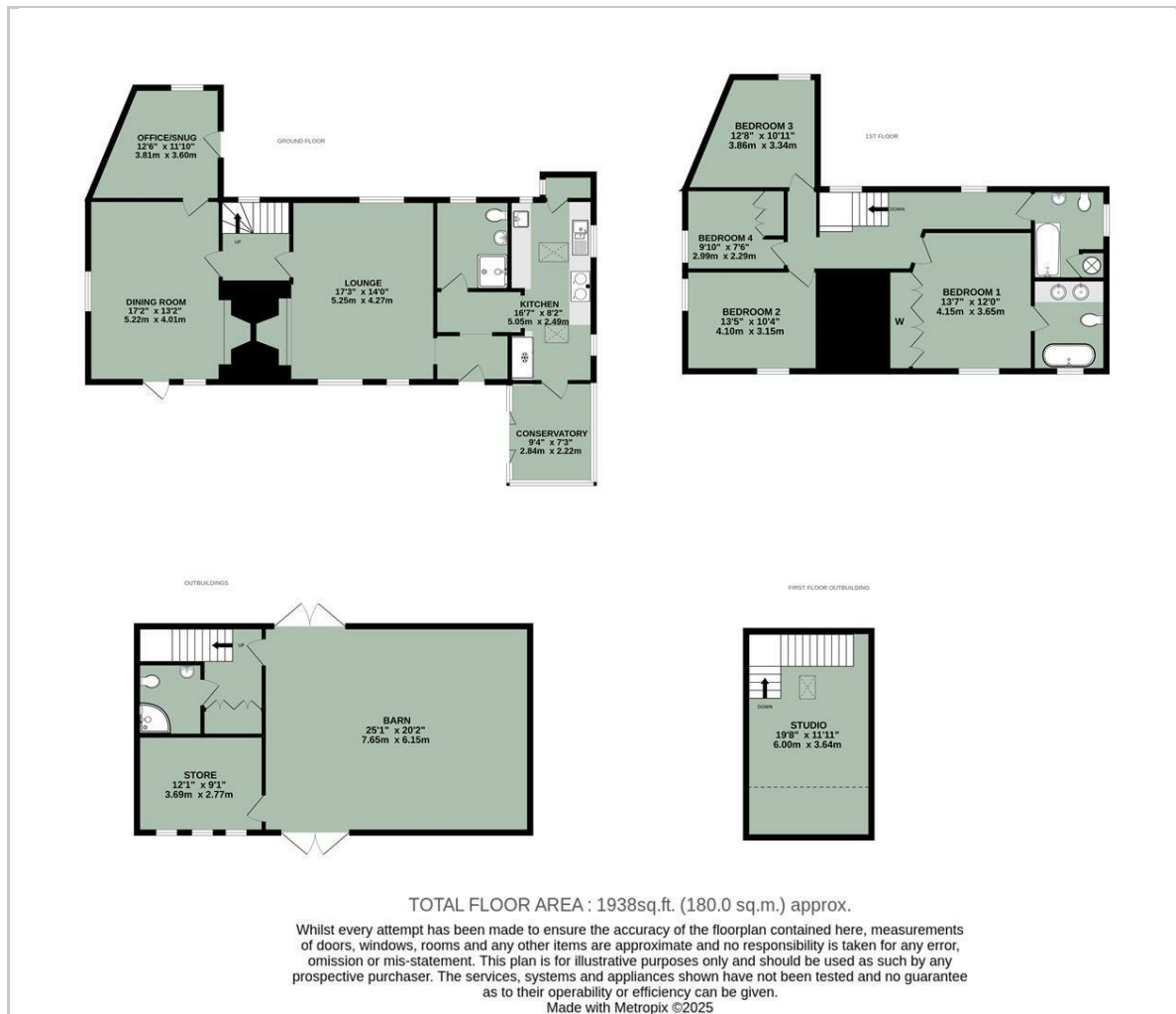

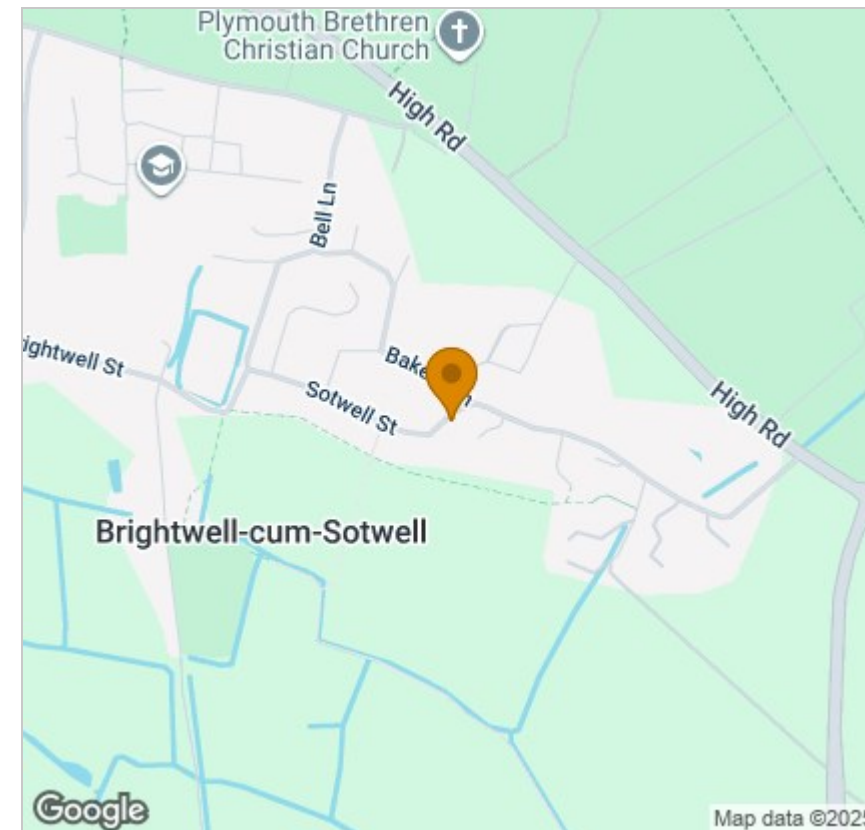


Energy Efficiency Graph
