Shibden Valley is located a short distance away boasting a network of walking routes and bridleways ideal for outdoor leisure and equestrian

Access is gained into the property directly off Howcans Lane into the driveway providing off road parking. The property is set within a generous expanse of gardens which surround the property totalling approximately 0.74 acres.
