Location & directions:

Threlkeld has its own post office (open three days a week), restaurant, coffee shop, pubs, primary school and a bus service and lies at the foot of Blencathra, east of Keswick, within easy reach of the A66 and the M6 motorway, only 4 miles from Keswick and approximately 14 miles from Penrith.

Directions

From the PFK office, head out of the town, take the A5271 eastbound and at the junction with the A591, bear left onto The Hawthorns and follow the signs for Penrith onto the A66. After approximately 4 miles, take the first left hand turning into Threlkeld village. before reaching the Horse and Farrier, turn left onto Blease road, continue up the hill and the property is on the left opposite the school.

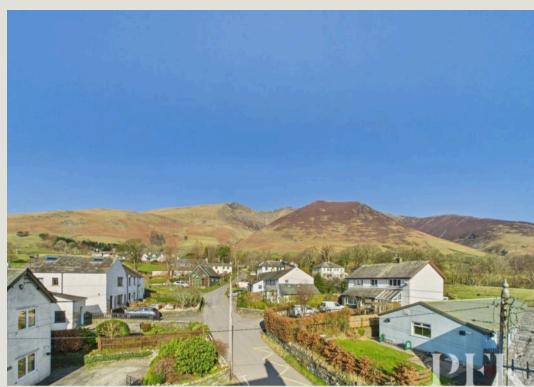
Velux window to rear, window and Velux to front aspect, exposed beams, undereaves storage and the panoramic fell views can be particularly enjoyed from this room.

Garden

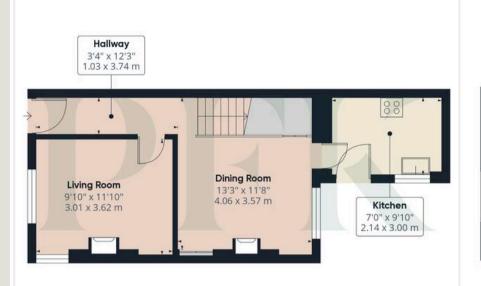
