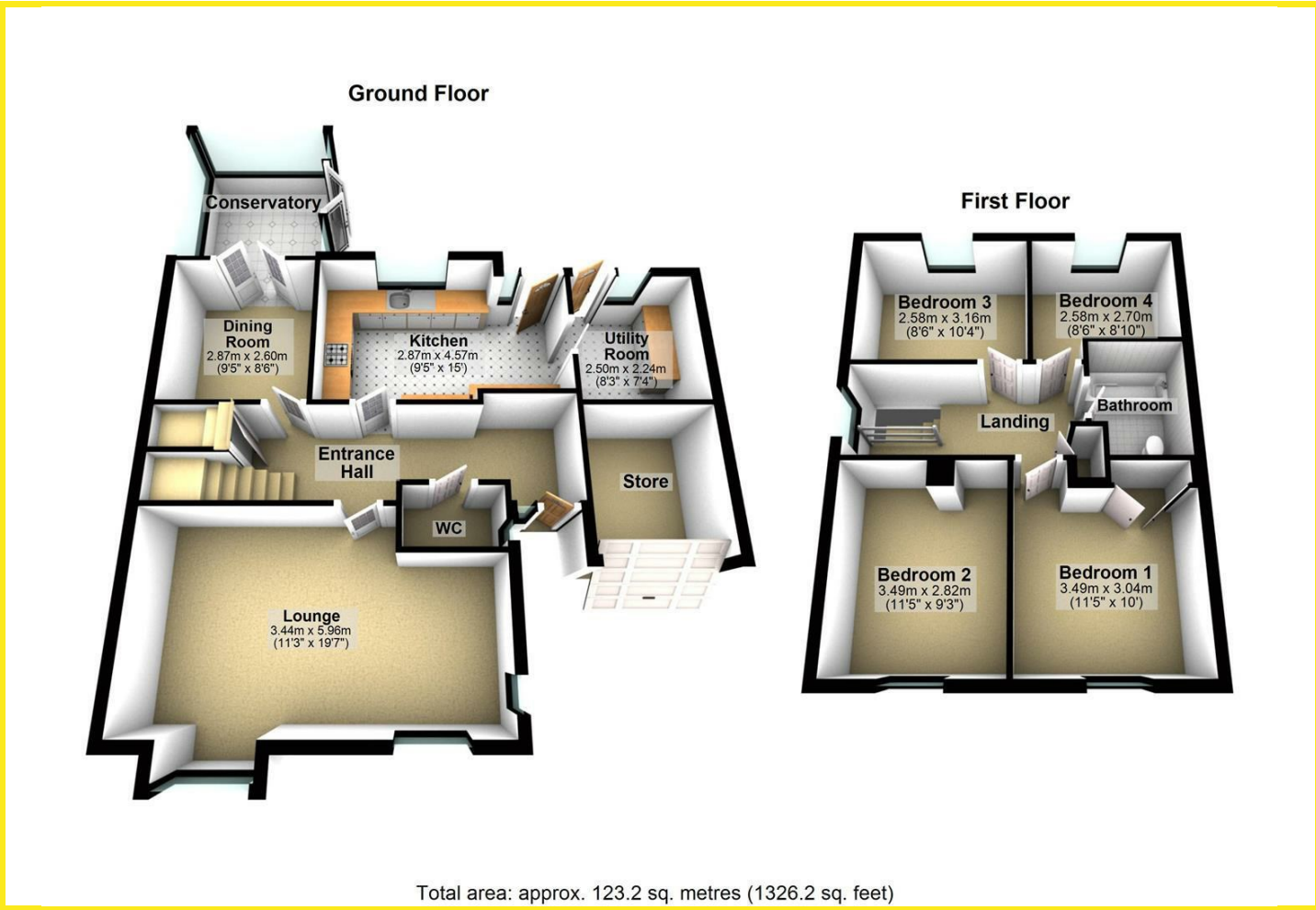

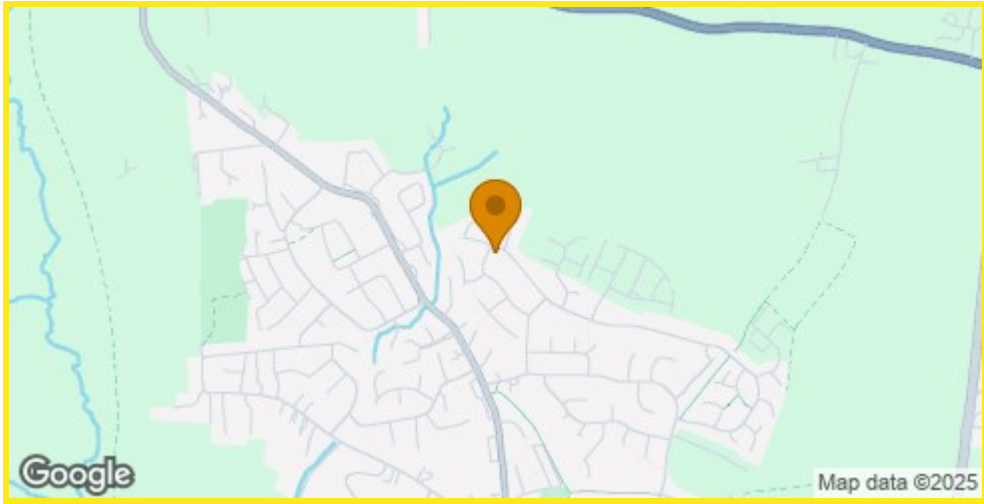




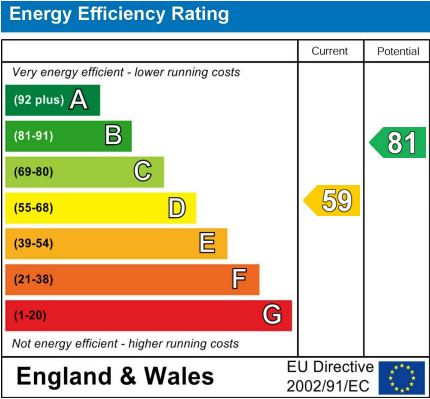
Floor Plan
