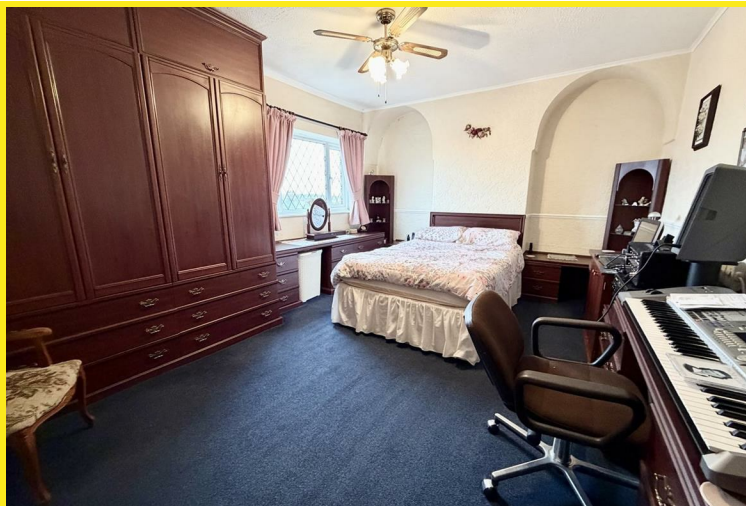

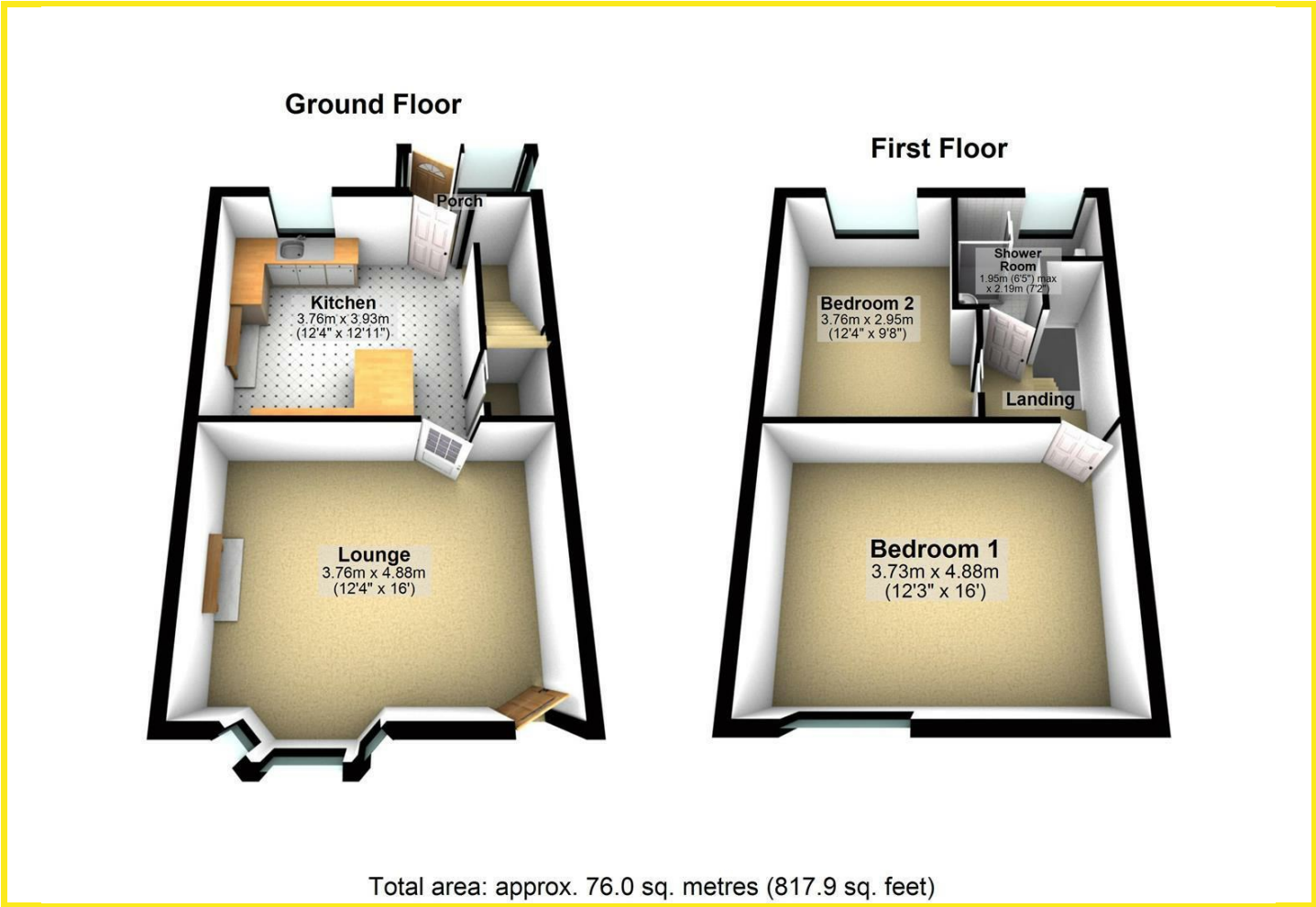

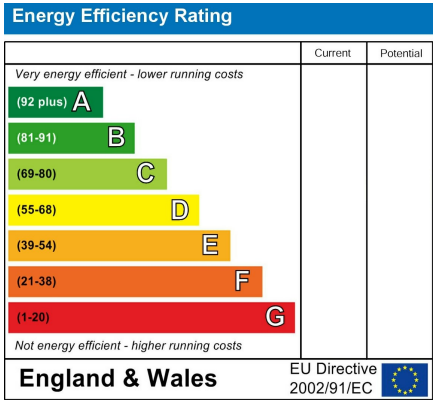
Floor Plan
