

The property enjoys period features which include sash windows and attractive ornamental fireplaces. Gas central heating can be found at the property and as well as newly fitted carpets.

Outside to the rear of the property is a paved south facing courtyard garden.



Location

The property is situated in a favoured Conservation Area less than a quarter of a mile to the renowned Festival Theatre and less than half a mile to the city centre. The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars and a mainline station to London Victoria. Goodwood is located to the north and is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are excellent sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.
