William Cawley Mews is an exclusive gated development conveniently located less than five minutes walk from North Street and adjacent to Chichester's renowned Festival Theatre. It includes some of the city's former alms houses as well as a mix of houses and apartments.

Built in 2004, this first floor apartment offers well-proportioned and includes a 22ft open plan kitchen/sitting room with double doors opening to the south facing balcony, two double bedrooms (one with en-suite facility) and a study/third bedroom. As well as a bathroom/WC there is also a useful utility cupboard.

Outside, an electronic gate provides vehicular access to the development which includes an allocated parking space, visitors parking and cycle and bin store.



The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars, the Festival Theatre and a mainline station to London Victoria. Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are superb sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering.
