














Approximate Area = 1705 sq ft / 158.3 sq m For identification only - Not to scale

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Location - The picturesque village of Itchenor provides an excellent sailing club, a popular local public house, the Quarterdeck Cafe and other village amenities including a church dating from the twelfth century and a village hall. There are local amenities in the nearby villages of Birdham and Wittering. The cathedral city of Chichester lies 7.5 miles to the north and offers a broad range of shopping, cultural and leisure facilities and the Festival Theatre. Other activities in the area include golf at Goodwood and Hunston, water sports and bathing from the beaches of West Wittering and East Head, horse riding and walking around the harbour and on the nearby South Downs. The mainline station in Chichester provides a regular service to London Victoria.

**Directions** – From Chichester proceed south on the A286 Witterings road. At the mini roundabout in Birdham take the second exit off signposted to West Wittering. After a short distance take the first turning on the right signposted to Itchenor. Proceed through Shipton Green and into Itchenor Road. Continue towards Itchenor where on entering the village the property is just after The Ship Inn on the left. what3words – drummers.sandwich.query
