Situated in the heart of the city centre this Grade II listed cottage, is steeped in charm and character. The property has undergone considerable yet sympathetic updating in recent years and is beautifully presented throughout.

Arranged over three floors the accommodation includes an open plan sitting room/dining room with an open fireplace in the sitting room area. The classic shaker style kitchen includes an integrated double oven, gas hob and an integrated washing machine. The principal bedroom has a feature wall with exposed beams and the bathroom is adjacent. Bedroom two is on the second floor.

A stable door in the kitchen opens to the delightful walled courtyard which has a herringbone design brick patio and is ideal for hanging baskets and pots. There is a small brick-built store and a gate to the car park at the rear which the owner pays £150 per annum to the local council for pedestrian access. No onward chain.


