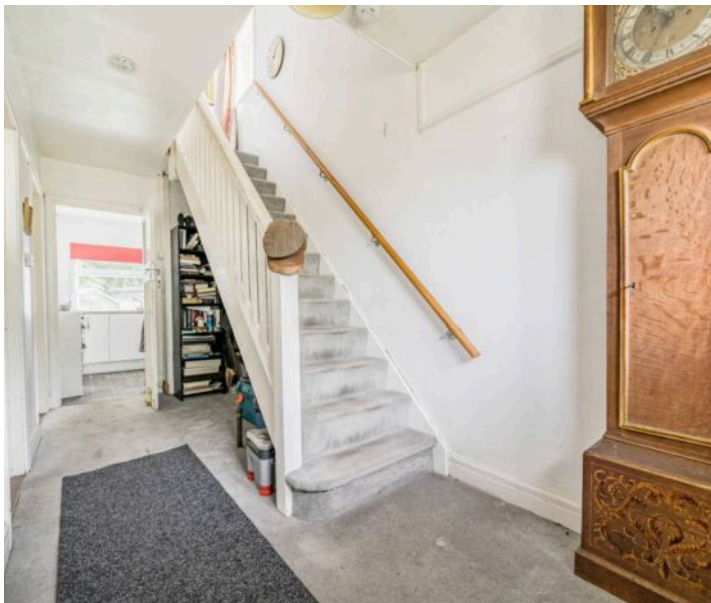
The house sits behind a wide, walled and fenced front garden, which currently features a driveway providing off-road parking for two cars. With some modification, this area could be widened to create additional parking or hardstanding, if desired. Although the property requires updating throughout, it retains a number of original features that add character and charm, including traditional interior doors and picture rails.



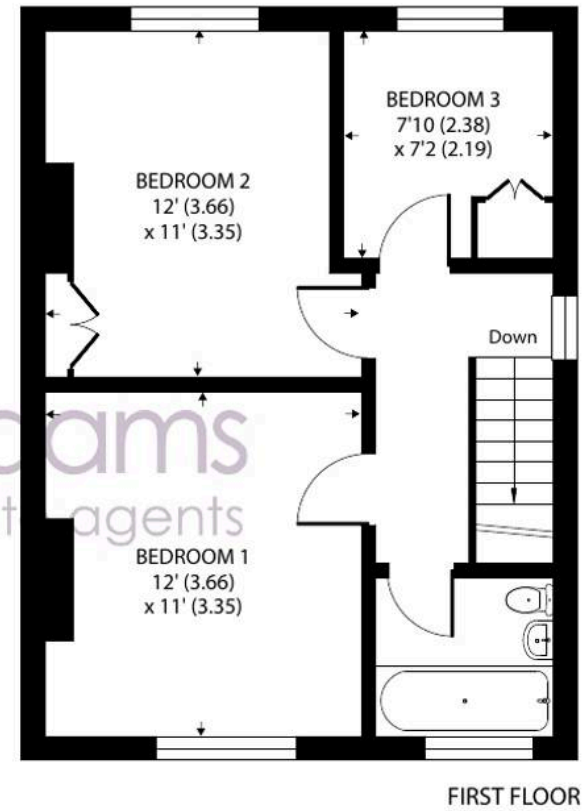


Inside, the accommodation includes a traditional entrance hall leading to an open-plan sitting and dining room. This room features French doors opening onto a south west facing rear garden, ideal for enjoying afternoon sun. The ground floor also includes a kitchen, a utility room and a shower room for added convenience. Upstairs, there are three bedrooms and a family bathroom.

Externally, the property has a long rear garden planted with mature shrubs and roses, creating a pleasant and private outdoor space. There is also a wide patio area to the side of the house, perfect for outdoor seating or entertaining, as well as a timber workshop providing useful storage.

Location - The property is within easy access to the city centre shopping precinct, renowned Festival Theatre and local primary schools. The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars and a mainline station to London Victoria. Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are superb sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.
