Offering generous and versatile accommodation throughout, the ground floor features a welcoming reception hall, a spacious dual-aspect sitting room with an attractive inglenook fireplace, formal dining room, kitchen with large storage cupboard and larder, a charming breakfast room and a bright conservatory overlooking the rear garden.









Upstairs, the spacious principal bedroom boasts a en-suite including a bath, shower, basin and bidet (no WC), while an additional bedroom also benefits from an en-suite bathroom. A third bedroom features a shower cubicle and there is a fourth bedroom and cloakroom completing the first-floor layout.

Set within over 1.5 acres of delightful grounds, the property enjoys beautifully maintained front and rear gardens, a tranquil copse and a paddock-style area offering privacy and outdoor space in abundance. Additional features include a double garage with electric door, private driveway and the advantage of vacant possession. **Location** - The village of Walberton has a thriving village community with interest groups and activities for all ages, as well as a range of local shops and golf course. A further range of shops can be found in nearby Barnham, as well as a mainline railway station to Brighton, Southampton, Gatwick airport, London Victoria and London Bridge. Walberton is also equidistant between Chichester and the historic town of Arundel. The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars, cinema, Pallant House Gallery and Festival Theatre. Fontwell race course and Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are excellent sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.

Proceed over the mini roundabout and at the next mini roundabout turn right into West Walberton Lane.
