Ideally situated just half a mile from the village centre and mainline station, it's perfectly placed for commuters and those seeking convenience.


The welcoming entrance hall opens into a light-filled sitting room, where a partially raised ceiling with twin Velux windows creates a wonderful sense of space.











The home features a timeless Shaker-style kitchen, three well-proportioned bedrooms and a modern bathroom with a shower-bath combination for both comfort and practicality.


Outside, the property offers an attractive open-plan front garden with neat lawn, a private driveway and an attached garage.




















Location - The village of Barnham offers a range of local shops, public houses, schools and mainline railway station to London Victoria. Nearby is Fontwell racecourse offering a season of racing whilst to the north west Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of flat horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. Barnham is situated between the cathedral city of Chichester which offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars and Festival Theatre and the historic town of Arundel. The area to the north is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the new South Downs National Park.

Directions - Proceed east along the A27 and at the Fontwell roundabout take the third exit off into Fontwell Avenue. Proceed to the end and at the mini roundabout take the first exit off signposted to Barnham (B2233). On entering the village of Barnham take the second turning on the left into Elm Grove which leads into Orchard Way.
