## Floor Plan

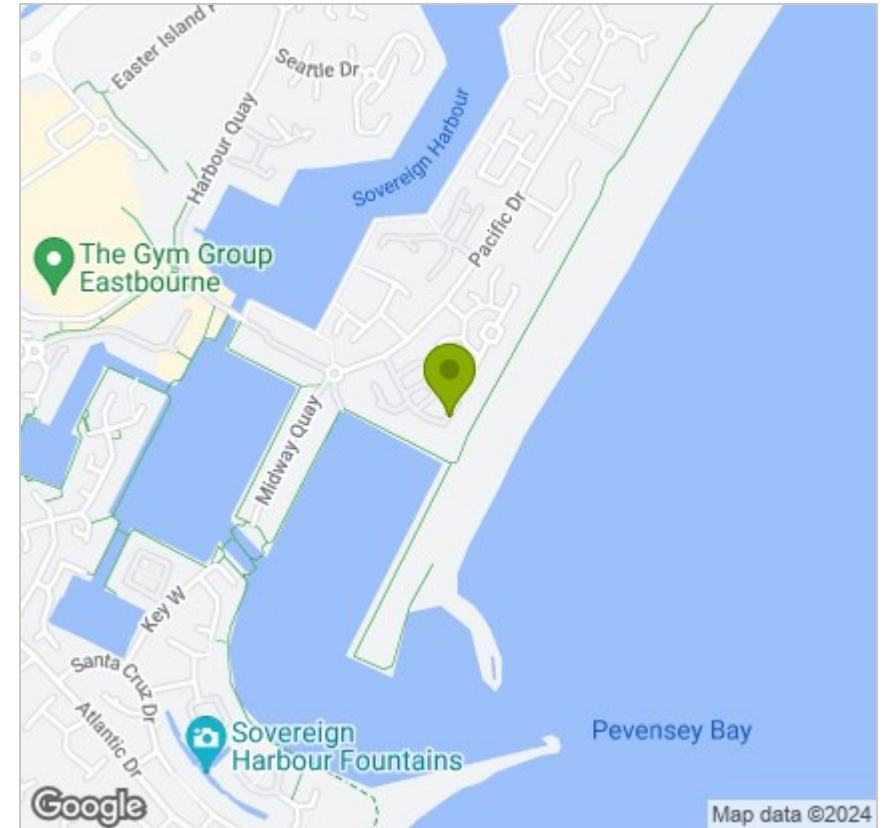
