SITUATION

Walford 2 miles, Ross-on-Wye 3 miles, Monmouth 10 miles, Hereford 18 miles, Gloucester 18.5 miles, Ledbury 19 miles, Cheltenham 26 miles, Newport 33 miles, Cardiff 45 miles, Bristol 55 miles. **Road Links:** A449 dual carriageway 4 miles, M50 (Jct 3) 11 miles. **Trains:** Hereford. Ledbury, Newport (fast train London) **International Airports:** Bristol & Cardiff 61 miles, Birmingham Airport 71 miles.

Bramley Cottage is an extended and renovated period property in a stunning location in Wye Valley AONB, with far reaching views towards the Welsh Mountains and Malvern Hills situated in the desirable hamlet of Howle Hill, which is mentioned in the Doomsday Book. Occupying an attractive rural position, the property is set back off a rural lane, and enjoys far reaching views across open countryside. The property benefits from excellent communications links with the M4, M50, M42 & M40 motorways all within easy reach providing access to the Midlands, London and the South.



Local, Sporting & Recreational The village of Walford offers a range of amenities including a village hall, primary school, public house and a church with more comprehensive shopping, cultural and education facilities found in Ross-on-Wye, Monmouth, Hereford, Newport and Cardiff.

The surrounding area provides a wealth of sporting and recreational opportunities, particularly in The Royal Forest of Dean which is renowned for its natural beauty. Excellent walking and cycling opportunities abound from the property with excellent outriding. The region is renowned for its strong equestrian industry and the property is well located for many competition centres. Hartpury College competition centre, David Broome's Centre, Bromyard Equestrian, Aberhall Equestrian, Prestige and Hunters Equestrian. Horseracing is at Cheltenham, Chepstow, Hereford, Ludlow and Worcester. Local hunts include Ross Harriers and Monmouthshire.

The property is constructed of stone elevations under a tiled roof, offering spacious family accommodation arranged over 2 floors and offers a wealth of character features including oak internal doors and solid oak staircase with galleried landing and a woodburning stove, with beautiful solid limestone flooring throughout the whole of the downstairs rooms. Throughout the property there are views of the surrounding countryside from all principal rooms.

Approached from a stone drive, the property is set back in its own private setting with gravelled parking area for several vehicles to the front. Easy to maintain garden to the front, side and rear of the house with patio area offers opportunities for outside dining.

Enter the property into the spacious Entrance Hall with glazed door to the rear garden, cloakroom and doors leading off to all principal rooms and stairs to galleried landing and first floor. The Kitchen is a beautiful handmade fitted maple kitchen with solid granite worktops, Aga with gas hob, with additional electric oven and breakfast bar. Archway leads through to the dining area with patio doors to the outside. Further archway leads through to the next reception room/formal dining room, with marble fireplace.

The main living room is a spacious, light room, with a tripple aspect taking advantage of the outstanding views. The room benefits from a woodburning stove.

The study/snug included the original inglennok fireplace.

On the first floor are 3 light and airy double bedrooms. The Master has built -in storage and an ensuite wetroom. There are 2 further double bedrooms, and family bathroom. All with high quality fittings.

OUTSIDE

The garden lies mainly to the front and side of the property with patio area to the rear. Double garage (23ft 4" x 17ft 4") housing a new Worcester combi-boiler. Water, electricity and drainage are connected. Across from the house is the stable yard consisting of 3 large looseboxes, plus foaling box, feed store and tack room. Stable yard has drive through access. Beyond the stables is the pastureland, which is flat with natural hedge fencing and direct access off the road.
