Externally the front garden is attractively planted & landscaped with flowerbeds & borders with paving & pathways leading to a patioed seating area. A Wisteria adorns the front elevation, sensational in full bloom! Above this is a roof terrace accessed via stone steps which in turn leads to a raised lawn with pretty stone walls & small orchard with apple, pear & green gauge trees plus fruit bushes. Further specimen trees include: Gingko, Acer Davidii Viper, Japanese crab-apple, cherry & oak. This is the perfect spot to enjoy some sunshine & soak up the views across the pretty garden & over the village beyond to the Avon valley. Gardeners will love this! Our client tells us the plot is circa quarter of an acre including 2 garden sheds, green house & log store. Note: there is no private off-street parking. On street parking is available outside the house.
