The central entrance hall has the kitchen dining room to one side & the sitting room on the other, these enjoy beams, panelled walls & a fireplace. There is a rear door to the garden and stairs to the two cellar rooms. The first floor has two bedrooms, one with ensuite shower room. We also find the family bathroom. the top floor has a central landing and two further bedrooms. 










Basement Area: 42.1 m² ... 454 ft²
