The porch leads to the entrance hall. To one side is the lengthy sitting room with square bay & fireplace sporting a cosy wood burner. The heart of the home will surely be the open plan kitchen dining room which spans the whole depth of the house. This is the perfect space for work rest & play with friends & family. Unusually there is a good utility room with adjoining cloakroom. The first floor has three bedrooms; there are two doubles looking out to the front of the house, the single is at the rear alongside the very attractive modern bathroom. 14 Churches is extremely well designed & presented both inside & out – essential viewing.

Externally there is a good rear garden being both wide & deep. It is hard landscaped for low maintenance with a durable astroturf lawn. We find a raised decked seating area making the most of the evening sunshine & is surrounded by pretty pot plants. We also find flower beds & borders pus a garden shed. The rear garden is surrounded by fencing. To the front the driveway is rather spectacular; it has an impressive, gravelled parking area, pathway to the front door, log store & even a swaying palm tree!
