SITUATION

Cerne Abbas is one of the most historic and picturesque villages in Dorset, surrounded by countryside and rolling downland. It is about 8 miles north of Dorchester with its comprehensive range of facilities including Dorset County Hospital together with good access to the Abbey town of Sherborne, about 12 miles to the north. Both towns have main line railway stations to London Waterloo as well as a regular bus service.
