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SITUATION

The village of Buckland Newton has a village shop, Gaggle of Geese public house, church, modern village hall and playing field. The village of Cerne Abbas, about 4 miles, has a doctors' surgery and pharmacy, 3 public houses and village store. There is some outstandingly beautiful countryside in the area which is well interspersed with footpaths and bridleways.

Dorchester, Sherborne and Sturminster Newton are about 11, 9 and 8 miles respectively, all offering shopping, educational and recreational facilities. Both Dorchester and Sherborne have a mainline train services to London Waterloo.
