This delightful end of terrace cottage has rendered elevations under a tiled roof. Believed to have been built circa 1880 the property is tucked away just off Glyde Path Road within a moments' walk of the town centre and all amenities.

The ground floor has been sympathetically extended to create light and spacious accommodation.

Upon entering the cottage on the ground floor a door leads into a good sized sitting room which has a wood burning stove and fitted storage either side. Off the entrance hall stairs lead up to the first floor.

The kitchen is next to the sitting room which has a range of floor and wall mounted units with space for white goods. Integrated appliances include; electric oven and hob with extractor hood over.

Off the kitchen, through a set of double doors, is the garden/sun room which provides plenty of space for table and chairs and enjoys a pleasant view.

On the first floor is a double bedroom with fitted wardrobe and bathroom with white suite comprise; w/c, wash-hand basin and bath with shower attachment over. Externally there is a small area of shrubs and floral borders.
