THE DWELLING

Offered with no forward chain, this first floor studio apartment within a Grade II Listed building, is ideally situated in the heart of Bridport town centre. The property offers a light and spacious living/dining area, kitchen with fitted base cupboards, and separate wc, basin and shower.

ACCOMMODATION

The front door opens into the main living area of the apartment, which benefits from a good amount of natural light from windows and a skylight. There are storage cupboards at the far end of the room. To the right is the kitchen which is fitted with a range of base units. Off the kitchen there is a shower, wc and sink.

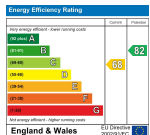
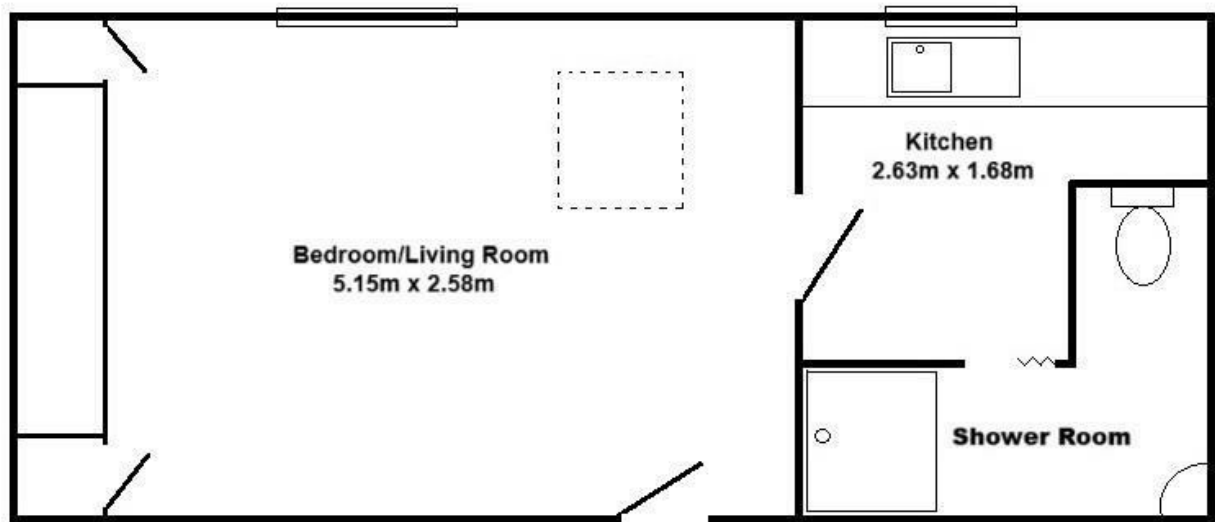
