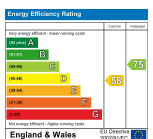


SITUATION

The property is situated in the hamlet of Higher Eype, close to the village of Eype itself. Eype is a small village to the South West of Bridport with attractive cottages and houses, a hotel and a public house and access to the South West Coast Path and the beach. Nearby Bridport is a bustling market town with a history of rope-making and is close to the World Heritage Jurassic coastline. It has a variety of independent shops, supermarkets, public houses and restaurants catering for a range of tastes and excellent arts and music events. West Bay is a walk along the coast, with its harbour and beaches and a variety of small businesses catering for everyday needs. Bridport is conveniently placed for Dorchester and Weymouth to the east and Axminster to the west. Walking, water sports, golf and riding opportunities are plentiful in the area.
