THE DWELLING

The property offers good sized accommodation comprising a light and spacious double bedroom, kitchen with wall and base cupboards and space for further appliances. There is also a good size living room and part-tiled bathroom fitted with a white suite.

ACCOMMODATION

This one bedroom apartment is very well located in a tucked away location in the centre of Bridport. The apartment would be ideal for a first time buyer or as a buy-to-let investment. It is accessed via a shared front entrance door with stairs leading up to the front door. One step up and to the left is the kitchen which is fitted with a range of wall and base units with space for white goods, and enjoys pleasant views over the town rooftops. There is a serving hatch through to the living room which is a good size and overlooks East Street. To the right of the living room is the bedroom, which is a generous double with space for wardrobes. The bathroom is fitted with a bath, wc, sink and storage cupboard. It benefits from natural light from windows at each end.

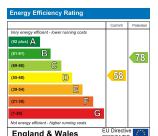
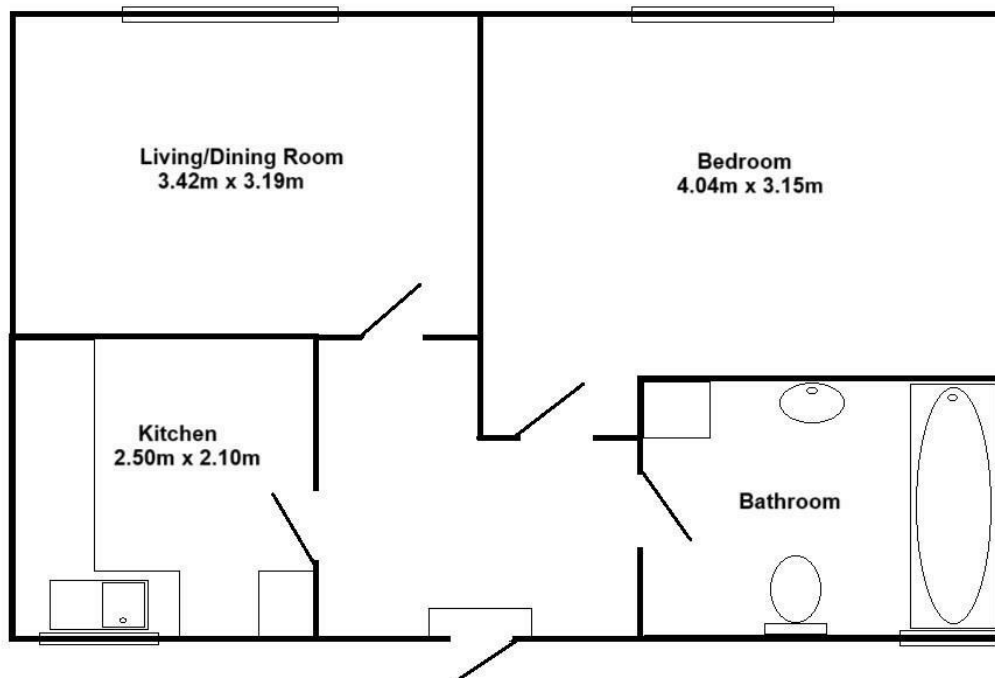
