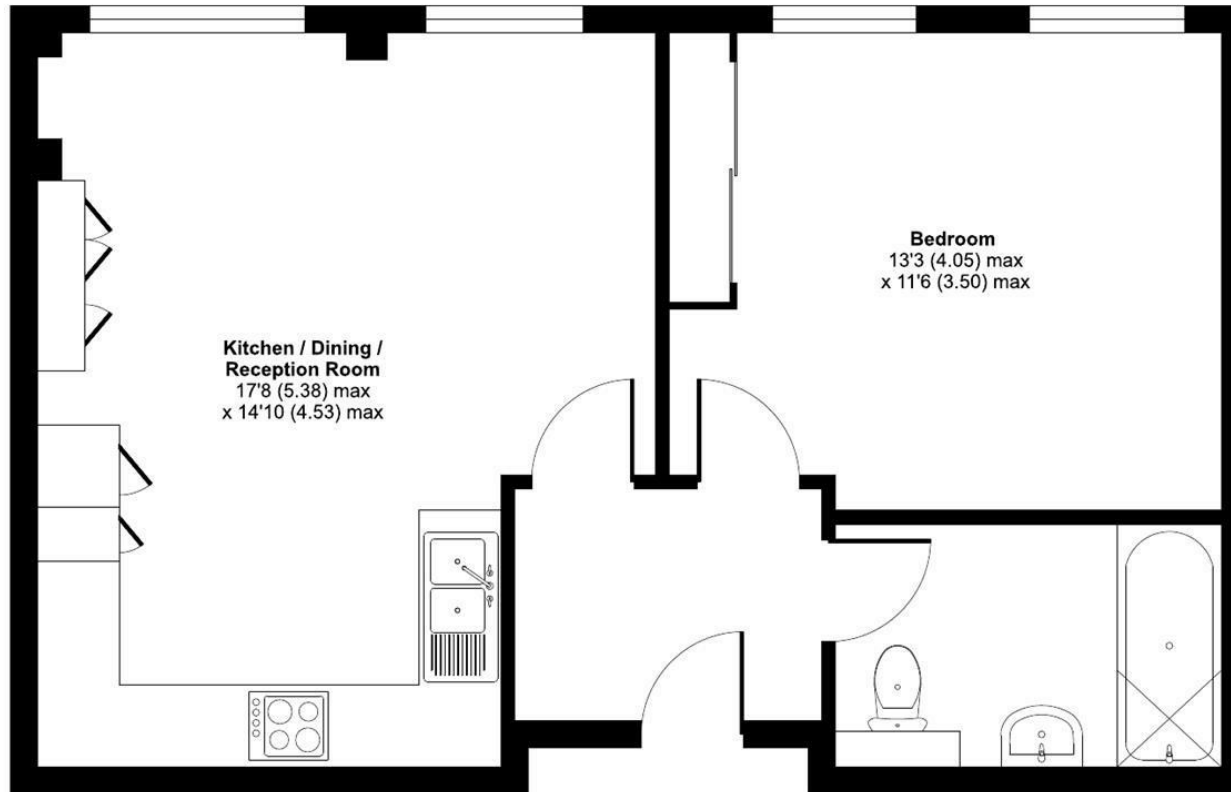




Uxbridge Road, Uxbridge, UB10
