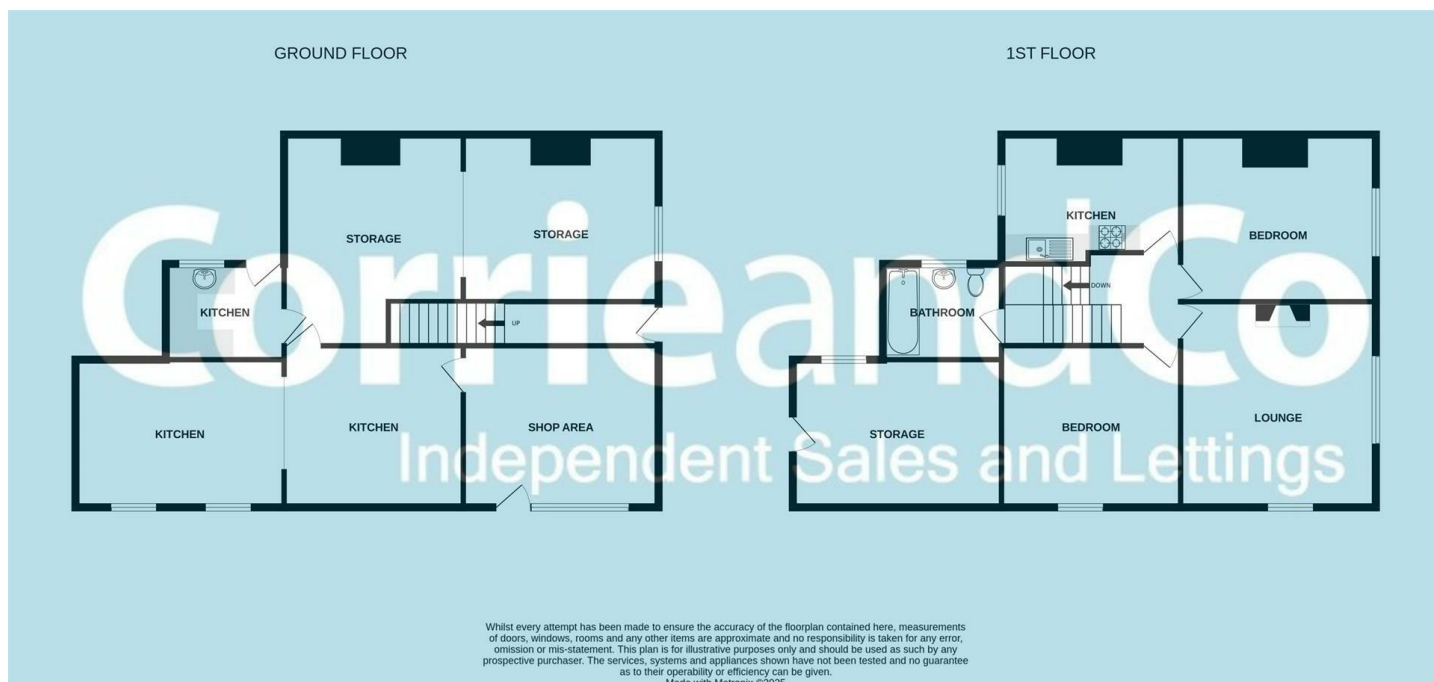
Road Map
