Boasting stunning views of Harlech castle and the Snowdonia mountain range, the cottage really is a dream home for a permanent relocation, or alternatively a successful holiday business with evidence of past income. In addition it has the extremely rare advantage of off street private parking and a pretty, low maintenance rear garden - with a vista of Harlech castle and the mountains beyond - in which to unwind.

The property is located in the town centre of Harlech, which offers a range of facilities including shops, restaurants, Post Office, schools, swimming pool and petrol station. It also boasts a cliff top castle and the Royal St David's Golf Club. There are good local bus services and the nearby stations along the Cambrian Coastline railway provide excellent links to nearby towns, including Porthmadog and Barmouth with regular services to the Midlands and beyond.

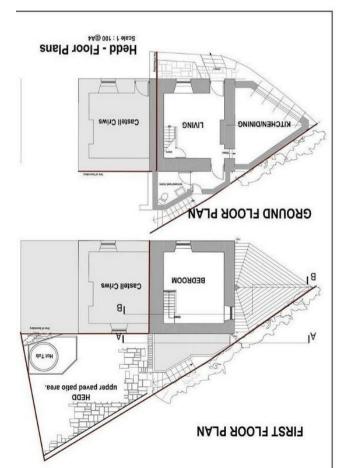
