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35 Barmouth Bay - a luxury, 2 bedroom lodge 2019 with full wrap balcony situated in a privileged perimeter position overlooking the sea. The "Willerby Portland" offers stylish and opulent open plan living area and boasts a comprehensive "Shaker" style fitted kitchen with high quality integrated appliances, a generous dining area and relaxing lounge with doors opening onto the balcony for indoor/outdoor living. The master bedroom includes ample storage with dressing area and en-suite and the second bedroom benefits from a large walk in closet. The quality continues in the family bathroom. Externally the lodge has its own private garden - the perfect spot to dine alfresco in the summer and star gaze during the winter months.

Barmouth Bay is an immaculately maintained lodge site which has the title of the prestigious 4 star AA holiday park. Park facilities include an indoor pool, playground, outdoor sports court and direct access to the beach.

En-suite: shower room comprising Linoleum to flooring, white W/C and pedestal sink, vanity unit with storage, corner shower unit, heated towel rail, window with modesty glass.

Carpeted, double bed and bedside cabinets, window to side aspect, radiator, large walk-in wardrobe (1.09m x 2.09m) with fitted storage.

SHOWER ROOM

2.17 x 1.70 (7'1" x 5'6")

Linoleum flooring, white suite comprising bath with shower over, W/C and sink unit with vanity unit and mirror, heated towel rail. Window with modesty glass to side aspect.

EXTERNAL

The lodge is situated in the most favourable position on the site and benefits from a spacious wrap around balcony complete with outdoor furniture included in the sale. Garden and parking.

MATERIAL INFORMATION

The park is not a residential site so the purchaser would need to have a permanent address proof of which will be required.

The park is open from 1st March until 10th January every year.

The licence for this lodge would expire on 1st July 2049 at which point the purchaser would need to remove the lodge from park or part exchange into a newer holiday home to gain a new licence.

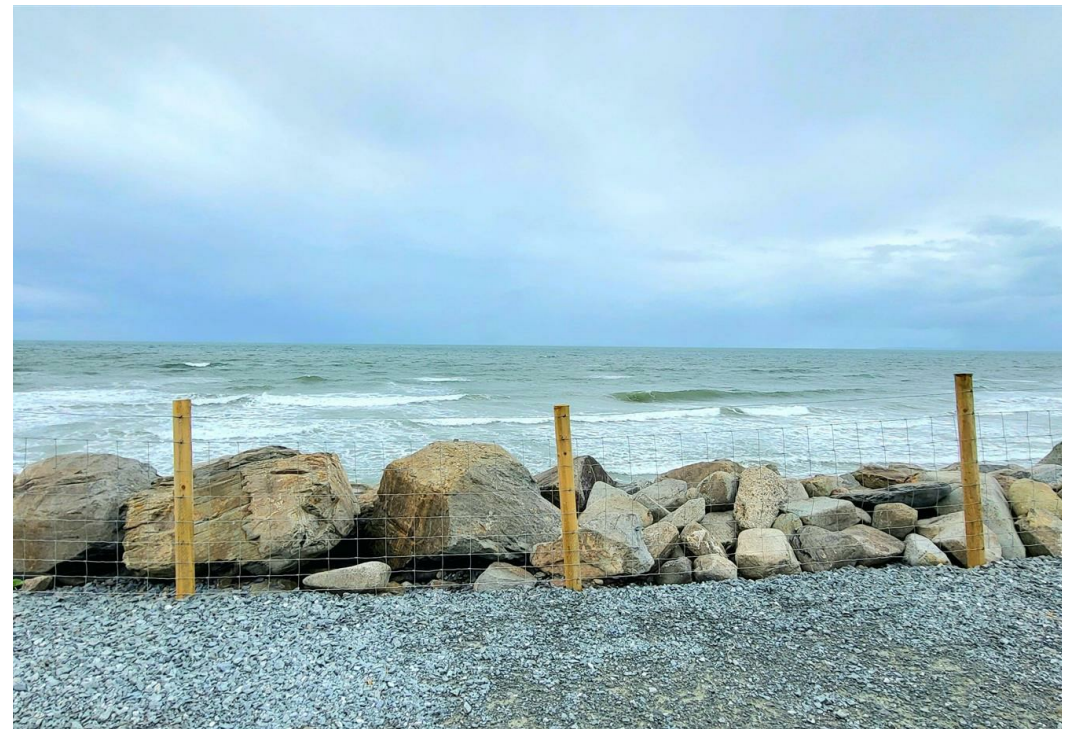

LOCATION

Talybont is known for its friendly atmosphere and strong community spirit, making it a wonderful place to spend time. It is a coastal village located on the western fringe of the Snowdonia National Park. Named after the very old road bridge in the centre of the village which goes over the Ysgethin river, the area has miles of glorious sandy beaches, and rugged and remote woodland, with rivers and waterfalls. Talybont also has a restaurant, public house and a railway station with links to the local towns of Barmouth and Porthmadog, and extending to the Midlands and beyond. The nearby village of Dyffryn Ardudwy provides very good local amenities including a school, village hall, shops and petrol station.
