The approved accommodation comprises; reception hall, dining hall/sitting room, second sitting room/drawing room, home office, kitchen family room and WC.

A galleried first-floor landing will provide access to four bedrooms, the principle bedroom with dressing room and en suite, the guest bedroom with dressing room and en suite, the third and fourth bedrooms sharing a bathroom.
