AbbotFox presents this high-specification two-bedroom ground floor apartment, set within a modern and highly sought-after riverside development.

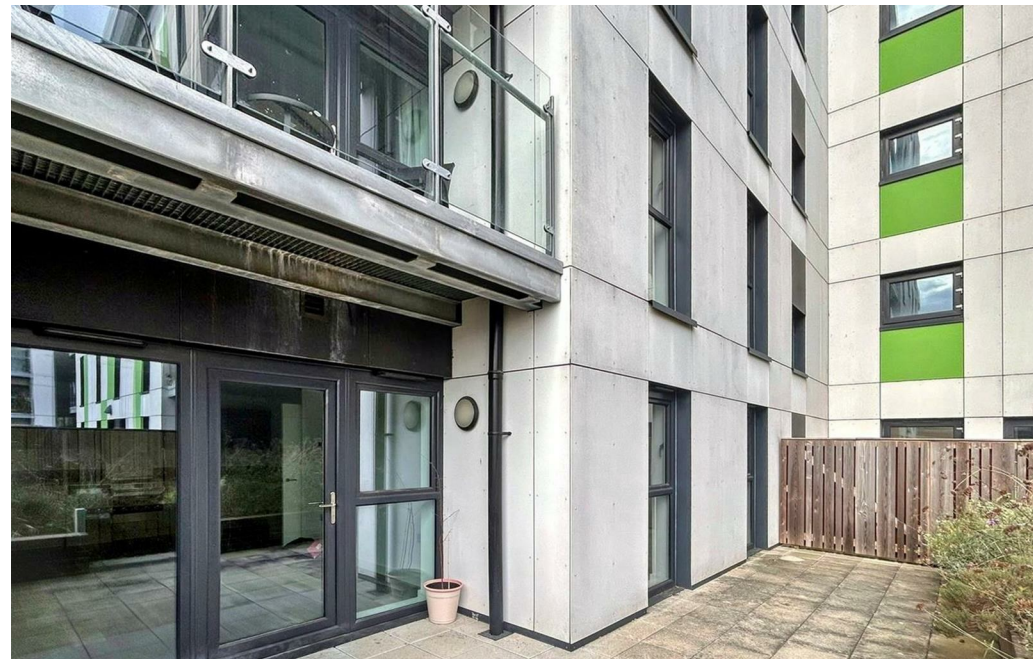
