

The Property

Built circa 1923, Central Hall served as a Methodist Mission Hall for many years. After the bombing of WW2 only the façade remained and, finally, some modern flats were erected in a modern and elegant style, creating a mix of well-appointed apartments.

The apartment is accessed via a gated entrance and then through the communal door.

The living area is a bright and generous space with ample room for both eating and sitting.

A well-appointed kitchen occupies a separate area away from the main living space and offers plenty of storage in a range of wall and base units finished with a black laminated work surface as well as a range of integrated appliances.

A set of stairs leads onto the spacious bedroom flooded with natural light via the large window with a pleasant leafy outlook. A modern and spacious bathroom completes the internal accommodation and is fitted with a white 3-piece suite with basin, WC and bath with shower and floor and wall tiles.

Location

With a rich history spanning four centuries, Bristol's modern day Old Market district has a unique character built from its vibrant residents and businesses alike. You will discover an eclectic blend of vintage stores and independent shops mixed with cool cafés, bars and restaurants as well as art and music venues. 
